Penn State Berks Dual Enrollment Program

General Information

Estimating Eligibility

Typical Dual Enrollment Applicants have:

High School GPA: 3.00

SAT score: 1000 (math & verbal)

ACT score: composite 21

PSAT score 100 (math & verbal)

Flexibility with these requirements is possible if the student has the support of his/her guidance counselor. Standardized test scores other than those listed above may be submitted for juniors.

Information required for each student

- 1) Dual Enrollment Non-degree Application (will be sent to counselors and available online at the Berks website: <http://www.bk.psu.edu/Admissions/27648.htm>)
- 2) Official high school transcripts
- 3) Standardized test score
- 4) Letter of support from guidance counselor or principal

This information is required for both juniors and seniors. University Park Admissions will review and approve applications for juniors.

Scheduling classes

High school seniors can enroll in up to eight credits a semester and earn up to 16 total credits. Juniors are limited to one course per semester. After being approved for the program by admissions, each student will be contacted by an academic advisor regarding scheduling classes. Placement testing will be required for those students wanting to take a math course.

Cost

Dual enrollment students will attend Penn State Berks at half the cost of tuition (through a 50% grant-in-aid offered by Penn State). If you have any questions regarding your Dual Enrollment tuition bill, please contact the Bursar's office at 610-396-6040.

Orientation

New (Fall semester) dual enrollment students will be invited to participate in a special orientation program to be held prior to the start of classes. The purpose of this orientation is to get students familiar with Penn State Berks, including Lion Path and Canvas.
