SAT/ACT Comparison



Category	ACT	SAT
Total Time	2 hours and 55 minutes (plus 40 minutes for the Essay [optional])	3 hours (plus 50 minutes for the Essay [optional])
Components	Reading, Mathematics, English, Science, Writing (Optional)	Reading, Mathematics, Writing & Language, Essay (Optional)
Scores	Scale ranging from 1-36 Composite score (1-36) & individual scores in each section (1-36), optional Writing (2-12).	Scale ranging from 400-1600 Mathematics (200-800), Reading & Writing (200-800), optional Essay (200-800)

These aspects of both tests are the same...

- Accepted at ALL colleges and universities in the United States
- Essay is optional
- There is NO penalty for guessing
- Scoring is based upon the number of correct answers that you provide

- Coordinate and expedite the flow of work and materials within or between departments of an establishment according to production schedules; include reviewing and distributing production, work, and shipment schedules; conferring with department superiors on production and completion dates; and compiling reports on progress of work, inventory levels, costs, and production problems.

Conventional occupations frequently involve following set procedures and routines. These occupations can involve routine data entry, file maintenance, and clerical tasks. Usually there is a clear line of authority to follow.

Enterprising

Enterprising occupations frequently involve starting up and carrying out projects. These occupations can involve selling, marketing, and business development. Sometimes they require risk taking and often deal with business.

Realistic

Realistic occupations frequently involve work activities that include practical, hands-on problems and solutions. They often require working with tools, machinery, and real-world materials like wood, tools, and machinery. Many of the occupations require working outside, and working closely with others.
