



2013 HIGH SCHOOL DISCOVERY CAMPS AT PENN STATE BERKS



Discovering Theatre Camp: June 24-28 - \$275

The Basic Theatre Camp is designed to introduce students ages 10-18 to all that is involved in putting on a live production. Participants will learn the casting/audition process; assemble a stage crew and learn the various crew jobs; work the stage through the use of cues, stage directions, and props; learn the acting process through voice projection exercises, staging practices, and play rehearsals; and finally stage an actual production.



Computers & Cyber Security Camp: July 8-12 - \$365

This camp will include problem-based instruction and hands-on activities with a strong emphasis on exposing students to computer security/information assurance careers, especially in the financial services industry. Participants will be involved in many activities to protect and defend personal privacy and information systems, and they will learn techniques for information system restoration by incorporating protection, detection, and recovery capabilities.



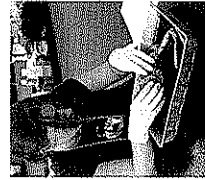
Engineering Camp: Rockets, Racecars, Robots - July 8-12 - \$365

Students will explore engineering, technology, and applied science, and learn about the various engineering disciplines—chemical, civil, electrical/computer, mechanical, and nuclear—through hands-on activities and projects. The camp will emphasize the role of engineers as inventors and developers of new products and processes for the benefit of society. Participants will also learn how best to prepare in high school to major in engineering in college.



Forensics Science Camp: July 8-12 - \$385

Participants will be introduced to the world of forensic science and will take a behind-the-scenes look at crime investigations and uncover a series of "who dunnits" using current forensic biological techniques. They will also use molecular biology to examine DNA left behind at the crime scene and ID the culprit. Participants will have the chance to interact with scientists and investigators as they learn and perform experiments to help solve crimes.



Veterinary Science Camp: July 8-12 - \$385

Combining hands-on experience with live animals with scientific principles in biology, chemistry, and anatomy, students will take on the role of veterinary assistants under the watchful eye of a veterinarian. Laboratory work, such as conducting dissections, reviewing ultra sounds and x-rays, taking cultures, and suturing, will be performed. Campers will also visit a veterinary clinic and learn about careers in the field.
