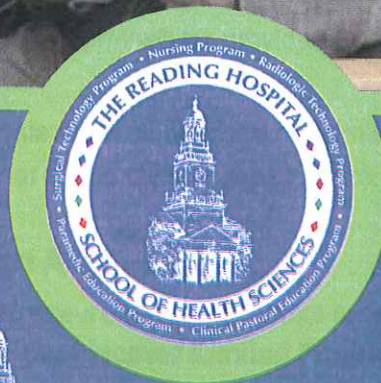
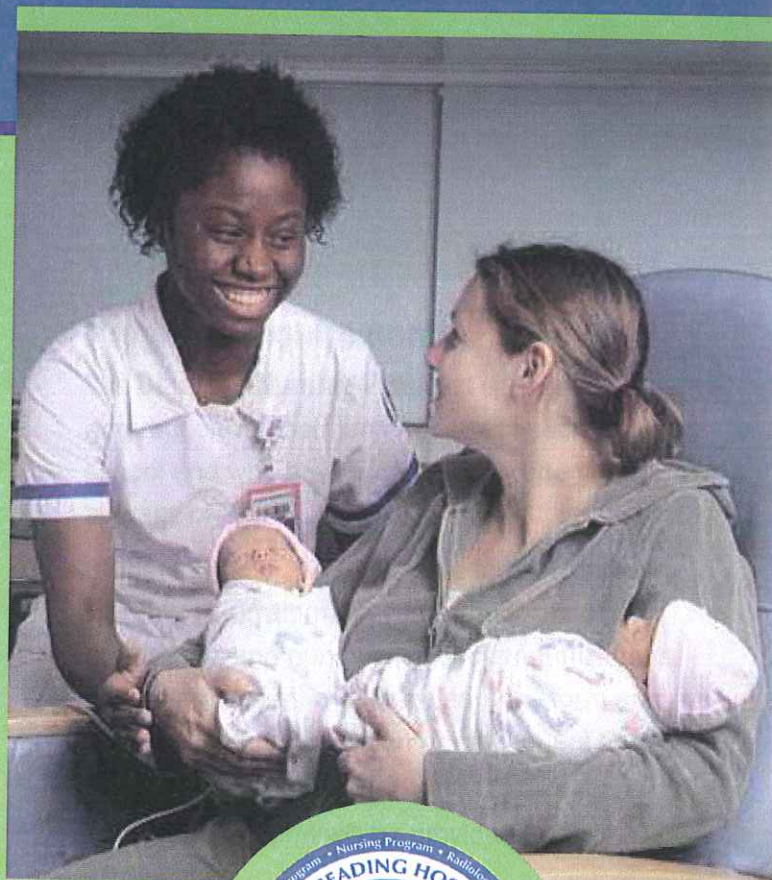

If you're considering a career in nursing and would like an up-close look at what nurses do on a daily basis, consider the **Discover Nursing Program** offered by The Reading Hospital School of Health Sciences.

This experience is designed to give prospective nursing students an opportunity to observe nurses within The Reading Hospital. You may get a chance to spend time in one of the state's busiest emergency departments and observe nurses working in maternity, pediatrics, or medical-surgical areas.

### Dates and Times of Discover Program:

**Discover Week** typically runs in June or July. The program includes an orientation session for participants (parents welcome to attend), and an activity schedule from 8 a.m. till 4 p.m. The session will run only when staff and resources are available.



### Program Requirements

The **Discover Nursing Program** is open to students entering either their junior or senior year of high school and who have a minimum grade point average of 3.0.

Students wishing to participate in the **Discover Nursing Program** must verify good school attendance and punctuality, and immunizations, as well as present a health clearance form and two letters of recommendation from teachers or other non-related adults.

Lunch and uniform will be provided to each applicant.

All materials must be received by Admissions two weeks prior to the start of the program.

### Program Availability

In order to assure that participants receive the full benefit of the **Discover Nursing Program**, the number of participants is limited to 12. Selection of qualified applicants is made on a first-come, first-serve basis.
