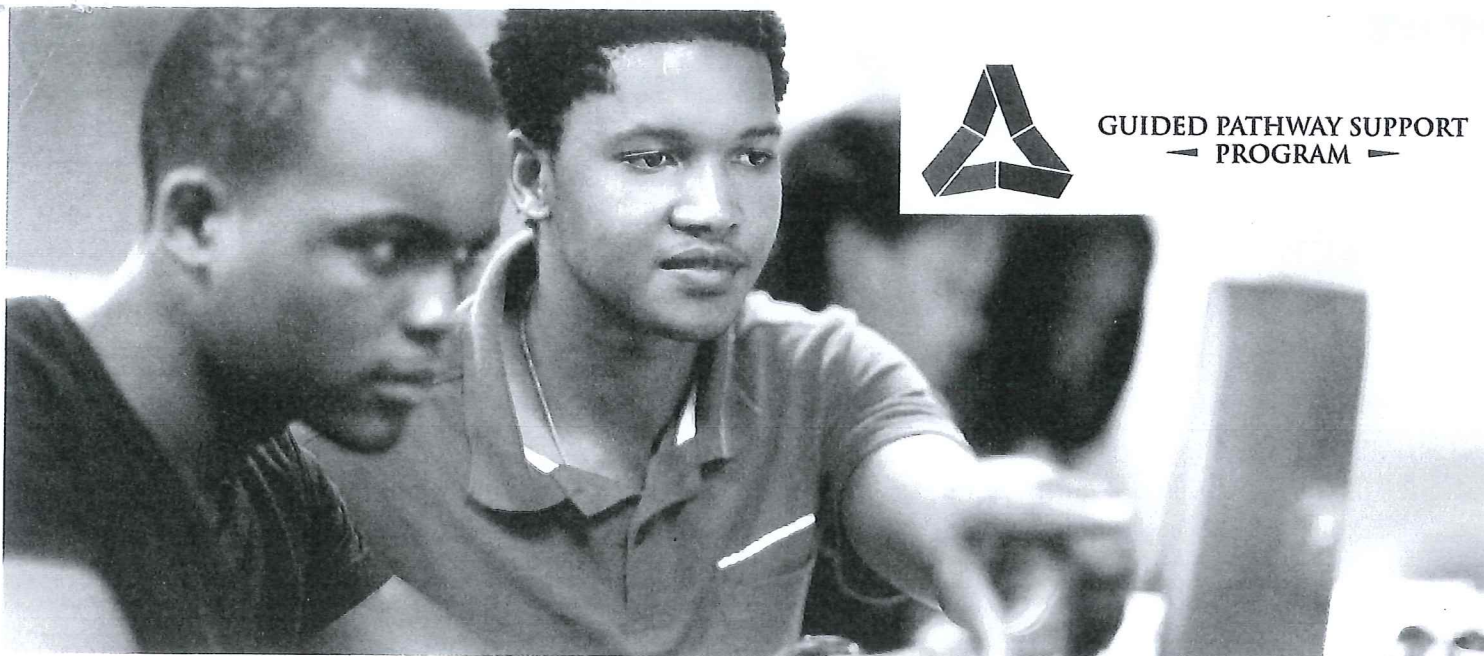

- Have demonstrated leadership and involvement at school and/or in the community
- Have a desire to enhance their college readiness skills and abilities.

What is required to apply to GPS?

- A completed online application
- One letter of recommendation from an academic teacher
- An unofficial high school transcript
- Two short writing pieces (to be submitted online with the application form)
