Law Enforcement Career Exploring is open to all young men and women ages 14 - 20 years old who have an interest in learning more about careers in the field of Law Enforcement.

The primary goal of the program is to help young adults interested in law enforcement choose a career path within law enforcement and to challenge them to become responsible citizens of their communities and the nation. Post 027 provides educational training programs for young adults on the purposes, mission, and objectives in law enforcement. - Team building

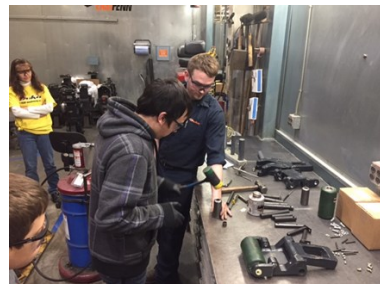
