1. You will choose one of the 50 states.
2. You will be required to present clues to the class about your state without actually giving your state away.
3. Your classmates will be using their books and computers to determine what your state is based on your clues.
4. You will need to present ten clues to your classmates about your state. For each clue you will need a picture or visual as a representation. You will put all of your pictures/visuals on a poster.
5. At the top of the poster you will need to have your state name written then covered so your classmates can't see your state name.

Clue 1= scrambled state capital

- Example= Harrisburg- ARGHISRURB

Clue 2= statehood year- 1925

- Example- multiplication problem= $77 \times 25 = 1925$

Clue 3= Write the state's current population in standard notation.

- Example= $1,000,000 + 900,000 + 99,000 + 9,000 + 400 + 30 + 5$

Clue 4= Create a drawing that represents your state nickname.
