## **Directions For Family Album**

### **80 points**

You will need 4- 9 x 12 pieces of construction paper (color of your choice). Put the 4 pieces together and create a booklet by stapling the left side close to the edge. You now have 8 pages. Listed are the directions for each page of your “**Family Album**”.

#### **Page 1: Cover Page (6 points)**

Create a cover page, it can be drawn on a separate piece of paper or created on the computer and glued to the first page of your album. The information should be large enough that it can easily be read and should take up the entire front page. This page should include the following information:

- Your name- first, middle, last
- Be creative use graphics, color, borders and/or pictures that relate to you and your family
- Class period

#### **Page 2: Treasured Family Memories (12 points)**

1. Complete “Treasured Family Memories” according to the directions on the paper.
2. Memories should include traditions and activities that your family does from year to year. It may also include a very special vacation or event. These memories **should not** describe the same holiday in every frame. Use complete sentences.
3. Don’t forget to color in the frames.

#### **Page 3: Family Tree (16 points)**

- Complete “Family Tree” according to the directions on Family Tree directions page of the of the album.
- If you are unable to complete any section of the tree you must attach a written explanation telling why the section is incomplete.
- REMEMBER: Use ink to complete this tree and use your imagination to make this page more colorful.

#### **Page 4: Family Photo Album (8 points)**

- Attach pictures of as many family members as possible including mother, father, siblings, grandparents and pets.
- Pictures may be digital prints, scanned photos or the actual print.
- **If you are unable to use family pictures you can use computer graphics, drawings or magazine pictures to illustrate family activities your family enjoys doing together.**
- Label pictures. Identify the people!

#### **Page 5: A family that Shares, Cares (10 points)**

- Decode the puzzle following the directions on the page.
- Clearly explain how you have shared the four decoded words at the bottom of the page.

#### **Page 6: “C” Family (8 points)**

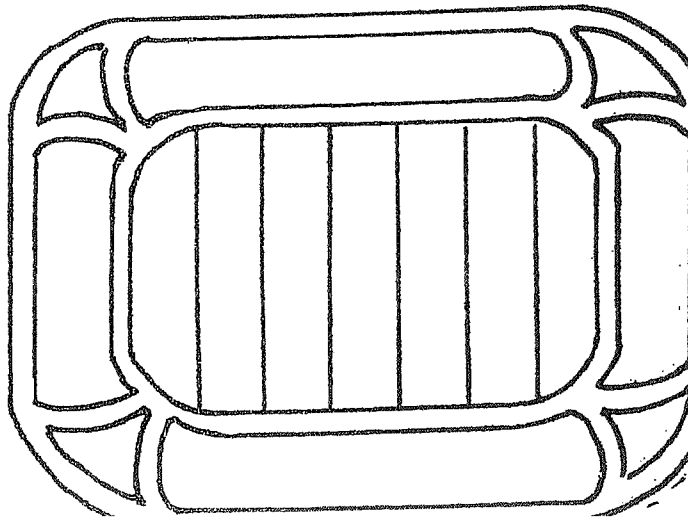
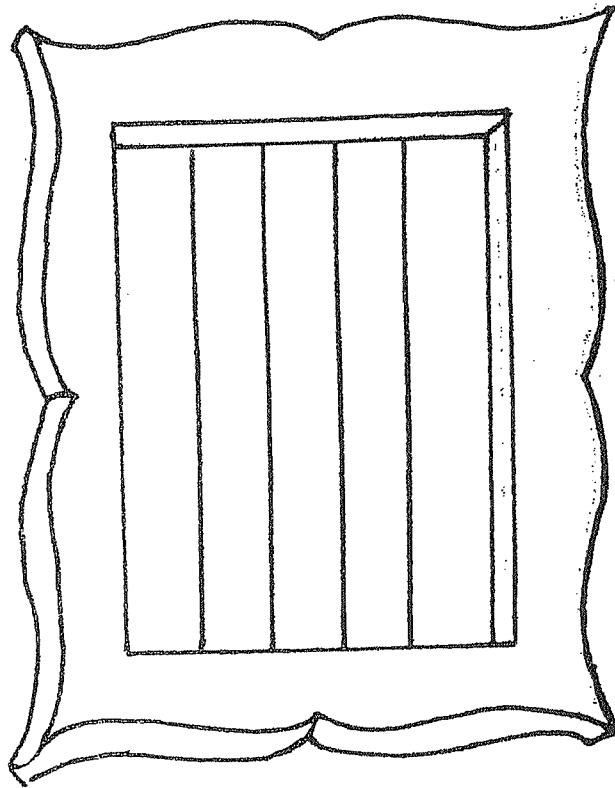
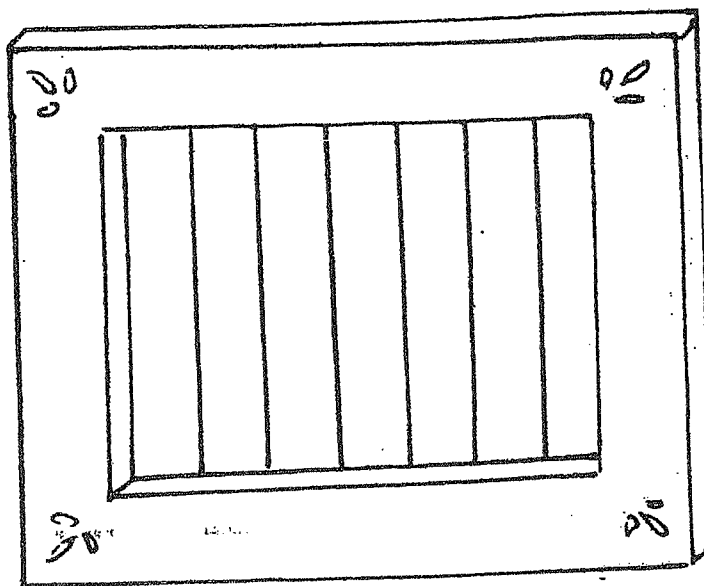
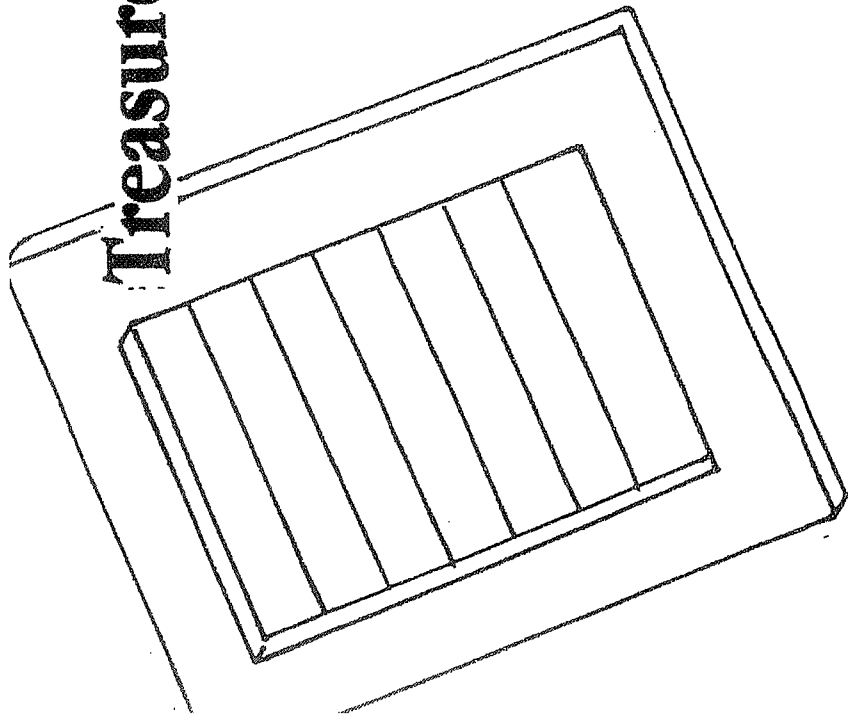
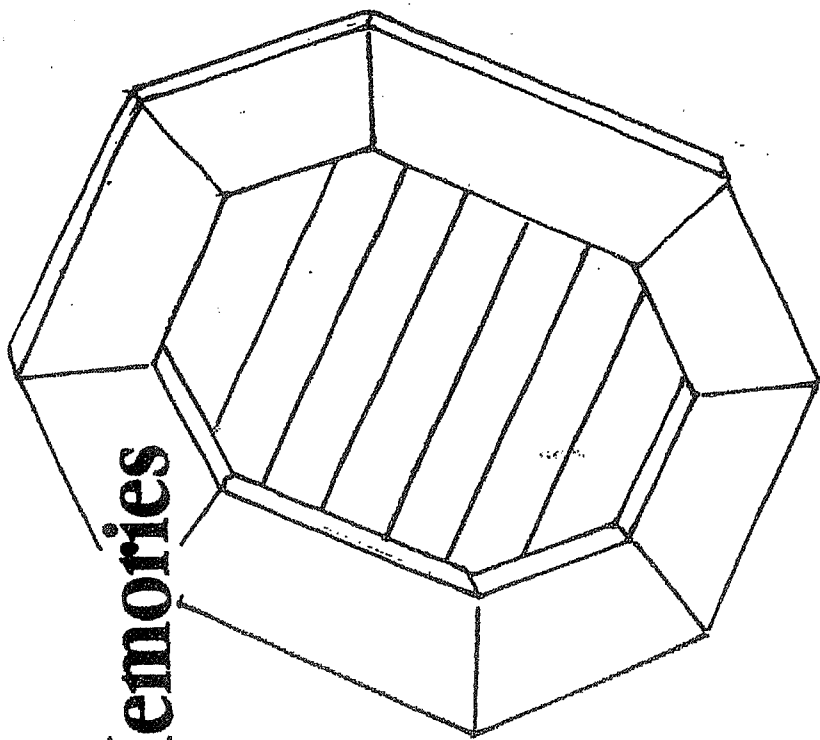

1. Use PEN or fine tip marker NOT pencil to fill in all names and dates.
2. Use your FULL NAME including middle name.
3. Include birthdates for yourself, siblings and parents. Write it out numerically. 6-4-95.
4. Write siblings first and middle names ONLY!! (Add last names for step/half-siblings.)
5. Use the maiden names for your mother and grandmothers. (their last name before they got married)
6. For fathers and grandfathers write, first, middle and last names.
7. Color the tree using colored pencils **NOT** markers.
8. If a parent, grandparent or sibling has died, they still must be included on the family tree mark that person with a (D).
9. If there is an additional name you would like to add because they are important to you, you may add them.
10. If someone doesn't have a middle name, place an X in its place. **First X. Last**
11. If you can not complete any section of the tree you must attach a written explanation telling why the section is incomplete.
