Exporting from Google Chrome

- Click the wrench icon  in the top right
- Click Bookmarks
- Click Bookmark Manager
- Click Organize
- Click Export bookmarks to HTML file
- Choose where to save this file

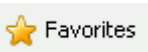
Exporting from Mozilla Firefox

- Click the orange Firefox button  in the top left
- Click Bookmarks
- Click Import and Backup
- Click Export Bookmarks to HTML
- Choose where to save this file

- Select your HTML bookmarks file

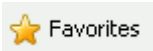
Importing to Mozilla Firefox
